With the Round Trip Track Pass, walking or biking the Queen Charlotte Track is easy and hassle-free, leaving you to do nothing but enjoy the experience.

Simply purchase your ticket, hand us your pack and cruise to your chosen start point along the track. While you walk or bike in freedom, we'll be busy ensuring your bag is at your accommodation when you arrive.

And when you're done, we'll be there to meet you for the boat ride back to Picton.

Your pass includes:

- Boat transfers for you and your bags to and from the track (Ship Cove/Meretoto to Anakiwa).
- Luggage transfers to your accommodation you only need to carry a day pack each day.
- One scheduled transfer per person across Endeavour Inlet from Furneaux Lodge to Punga Cove if you wish.
- If you want to skip a section of the track, we can transfer you to another point along the track for an additional charge.
- Please note we do not transfer luggage in reverse, eg the end of the track from Anakiwa to...etc.
- Excludes QCTLC Track Pass fee, which can be purchased online here.
- Taking a bike incurs an additional charge (\$20/person standard bike, \$40/person e-bike return).





Important information

- Only packs carrying the Cougar Line official label will be transferred. You will receive labels when you first check in at the Cougar Line office in Picton.
- Pleasure ensure that sleeping bags, tents etc. are securely fastened to your pack.
- When checking in at the Picton Cougar Line office before departure, we will record your daily pack transfer requirements. If you need to alter your pack transfer, you may advise our office by 5pm the evening before the transfer: +64 3 573 7925 | info@cougarline.co.nz
- Packs must be placed ready for collection by 9am each day with the next day's new destination label. Please confirm pack transfer arrangements with your accommodation host.
- Campers, please return your packs to the same location you picked them up from. Your pack will
 then be delivered to the destination on the next label.
- The connecting jetty for The Portage and Cowshed Bay campsite is at Torea Bay, a distance of 2km over the hill. The Portage provides a transport service for packs from/to the Torea Bay Jetty for a small fee per bag each way. Cowshed Bay campers can collect packs from The Portage and drop them there the next morning. Packs must be clearly labelled with The Portage or Cowshed Bay.
- Choosing to boat portions of the track instead of walking will incur an additional charge.
- While we take all reasonable care of your luggage, please understand that any luggage is transferred "at limited carrier risk".

Punga Cove to Bay of Many Coves	12km	4 hrs
The Portage to Mistletoe Bay	8km	4 hrs
Mistletoe Bay to Anakiwa	13km	4 hrs
